Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of road/National Highway (NH) projects in the country which are being funded by the International Financial Institutions including World Bank, State-wise;
- (b) whether some States have not taken up or initiated these projects despite sanction of funds;
- (c) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor, State-wise including Andhra Pradesh; and
- (d) the action taken or being taken by the Government to complete these projects?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI SARVEY SATHYANARAYANA)

(a) to (d) Ministry of Road Transport & Highways is primarily responsible for development and maintenance of National Highways in the Country. At present, there is only one National Highway Project being funded by International Financial Institution (Asian Development Bank), namely Rajmaarg Chauraha to Lakhnadon section of NH 26 in the State of Madhya Pradesh at a cost of Rs. 251.03 crores.
