Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the four-lane road under East-West Corridor and National Highway (NH)-77 in Muzaffarpur in Bihar have been covered from three sides and one side is left;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; (
- (c) whether the four-lane ring road in Muzaffarpur will be completed with the construction of Madhol to the right Mushahari via Magholi on NH-77; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the action taken by the Government in this regard?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI SARVEY SATHYANARAYANA)

- (a) & (b) Muzaffarpur is connected from all sides by road improvement projects under National Highways Development Project (NHDP), which include 4-laning of Muzaffarpur-Darbhanga Section of NH-57, 4-laning of Muzaffarpur-Gopalganj Section of NH-28, 2-laning with paved shoulder of Muzaffarpur-Barauni Section of NH-28 (which includes 4-laning near Muzaffarpur), 2-laning with paved shoulder of Muzaffarpur-Sonbarsa Section of NH-77 and 4-laning of Muzaffarpur-Hajipur Section of NH-77 including Muzaffarpur bypass.
- (c) to (d) There is no proposal for construction of ring road around Muzaffarpur as part of National Highways Development Programme.
