DEVELOPMENT OF ROADS IN NORTH EAST AND NAXAL HIT AREAS

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the success rate of Special Accelerated Road Development Programme for North-Eastern States and construction of roads in Naxal-hit areas of the country is less than 15 per cent;
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with the reasons therefor and the reaction of the Government thereto;
- (c) whether the Government has fixed any accountability in this regard; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

Answer

(a) to (d) No Madam. The rates of success of SARDP-NE and Naxal-hit areas are more than 30% and 45% respectively. However, the progress in these areas is affected due to very short working season, remoteness of the localities, difficult terrain/geological conditions etc.
