(a) to (c) Entry Fee for Category B Internet Service Authorisation in Unified Licence regime has been reduced to Rs. 2 Lakh from Rs. 15 Lakh. Further Category C Internet Service Authorisation in Unified Licence regime has been introduced with an entry fee of Rs 20000/-
