Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government has prescribed a time lag of seven working days for effecting Mobile Number Portability;

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) whether the time lag is linked to any security issues and if so, the details thereof;

(d) whether the Government proposes to reduce this time lag to two hours as prevalent in various countries; and

(e) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMUNICATIONS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY (SHRI MILIND DEORA)

(a) to (e) Keeping in view the operational requirements of law Enforcement Agencies, a maximum time period of seven working days for completion of a porting request in all licenses service areas except in the case of J&K, Assam and North East licensed service areas has been prescribed. In the case of J&K, Assam and North East, maximum time allowed for completion of a porting request has been prescribed is 15 working days. At present there is no proposal for reducing the time to 2 hours.
