- (a) & (b): All essential amenities, as per the norms, have been provided at Salem Railway Station. The station has also been developed under 'Modern', 'Model' and 'Adarsh' Station Schemes. Further, augmentation/improvement of passenger amenities at railway stations is a continuous process.
- (c) & (d): Yes, Madam. The following services announced in Railway Budget 2013-14, will provide day connectivity from Salem junction to different destinations:-

- 2. 18568 Kollam Vishakhapatnam express (weekly)
- 3. 16565 Yesvantpur Mangalore Express (weekly)
- 4. 16566 Mangalore Yesvantpur Express (weekly)
