(a) to (e) : Government has approved the proposal of public sector oil marketing companies (OMCs) to supply LPG at non-subsidized rate through Company Owned Company Operated (COCO) Retail Outlet (RO) for implementation on a pilot basis in Chennai, Delhi, Kolkata, Mumbai and Bangalore subject to statutory clearances of Oil Industry Safety Directorate (OISD)/Petroleum and Explosives Safety Organisation (PESO).
