- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government has taken up any measure to protect and preserve such a rare animal; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

(a), (b), (c) & (d) Yes, Sir. Recently three new species of Caecilians have been reported in Manipur and Nagaland. As per the information available in the Ministry, it has increased the number of Caecilian species found in North East Region to seven. Most of these species occur within the Protected Areas. The species occurring within Protected Areas are protected under Section 29 of the Wildlife (Protection) Act 1972.
