- (a) & (b): High Level Committee on the Status of Women was set up on 27.02.2012 by the Ministry of Women & Child Development, to undertake comprehensive study of Women since 1989 as well as to evolve appropriate policy interventions based on a contemporary assessment of women needs. However, consequent upon the resignation of Chairperson, Member Secretary and three members owing to their pre- occupations and pressing commitment, the committee was reconstituted on 24.05.2013. The reconstituted Committee comprises of Chairperson and 12 Members.
- (c) to (e): As per Terms of Reference, the reconstituted Committee is to complete its assignment and present its report to this Ministry within two years from its reconstitution.
