SUPPLY OF LONG LASTING INSECTICIDAL NETS

Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has supplied Long Lasting Insecticidal Nets (LLINs) to all the States/UT including Gujarat under the World Bank aided project on malaria control in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State/ UT-wise; and
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor along with the time by which supply of Long Lasting Insecticidal Nets (LLINs) is likely to be made to the remaining States/UTs?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI GHULAM NABIAZAD)

(a) to (c) Government of India has supplied LLINs to States covered under the Phase-I of the World Bank aided project for malaria control. State of Gujarat is in Phase-II. The State-wise supply details of number of nets are as under:

1 Andhra Pradesh 10.06 lakh

2 Chhattisgarh 10.03 lakh

3 Jharkhand 06.60 lakh

4 Madhya Pradesh 07.08 lakh

5 Odisha 38.02 lakh

Total 71.79 lakh

No time lines can be specified at this stage for supply of LLINs under Phase-II of the World Bank Project.
