(a) & (b): Maintenance and upkeep of coaches is a continuing requirement and this is carried out periodically during laid down maintenance schedule in open line depots as well as periodic overhauls in the Workshops in Zonal Railways. Besides, the coaches are also given a 'Mid-life' rehabilitation after 12-15 years of usage to restore their conditions.
