VACANT POSTS OF TEACHERS UNDER SARVA SHIKSHA ABHIYAN

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the posts of teachers sanctioned by the Union Government under Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA) have not been filled up by some States;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise;
- (c) whether the Union Government has taken steps for filling up of teachers posts in these States; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

Answer

MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI KAPIL SIBAL)

(a) Yes, Sir.

(b) to (d): Of the 33 States/UTs that have been sanctioned teachers under SSA, the States of Andhra Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Goa, Tamil Nadu, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Delhi and Lakshadweep have completed the recruitment. Arunachal Pradesh, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Jharkhand, Karnataka, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Orissa, Punjab, Uttar Pradesh, Chandigarh, Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Puducherry have recruited more than 80% of the teachers sanctioned under Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA), so far.

States/UTs have been directed to expedite the appointment of teachers. The status of teacher recruitment is being monitored on a regular basis.
