(a)&(b) The Union Cabinet in its meeting held on 9th May, 2013 has decided to constitute a standing Inter-Ministerial Group (IMG) to remove the bottlenecks and to provide the right coordination mechanism for the development of aviation hubs in India.

(c)&(d) Yes, Madam. Proposals for setting up of greenfield airports in various states are received from time to time in this Ministry. This Ministry has accorded `in principle` approval to 15 greenfield airport projects and ``site clearance``has been accorded to 5 greenfield airport projects.
