- (a) whether there are no special educators for teaching the handicapped students in Kendriya Vidyalayas in Delhi;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the action taken by the Government in this regard?

Answer

MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT(SHRI KAPIL SIBAL)

(a) to (c): There are no special educators on regular basis in Kendriya Vidyalayas (KVs). However, affirmative initiatives taken by KVs include waiver of fee for disabled students and reservation of 3% seats for them for fresh admission. In some KVs, assistance of nongovernment organizations (NGOs) are taken for special coaching and counseling of those children.
