## Will the Minister of ENVIRONMENT AND FORESTS be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government has any proposal to declare the Kudremukh forest in Karnataka as "Tiger Reserved Area";

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) whether the State Government of Karnataka has written a letter to Union Government for seeking withdrawal of its decision in this regard;

(d) if so, the details thereof; and

(e) the steps taken by the Government in this regard?

## Answer

MINISTER OF THE STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) IN THE MINISTRY OF ENVIRONMENT AND FORESTS (SHRIMATI JAYANTHI NATARAJAN)

(a) & (b) Based on a proposal received from the State Government, the National Tiger Conservation Authority has accorded approval for creation of the Kudremukh Tiger Reserve in Karnataka.

(c) & (d) As per communication received, the State Government has decided not to declare the Kudremukh National Park as a tiger reserve.

(e) The permission for creation of Kudremukh Tiger Reserve has not been withdrawn.
