- (c) the time by which it is likely to be set up?

MINISTER OF THE STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) IN THE MINISTRY OF ENVIRONMENT AND FORESTS (SHRIMATI JAYANTHI NATARAJAN):

(a) to (c) Under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme Project Elephant, a provision for securing elephant corridors is listed as one of the activities for which central assistance can be provided to the states. The activities are proposed by the states in their respective Annual Plans of Operations for Project Elephant.

No proposal has been received from the state of Odisha for any activity for securing a corridor at Sundargarh.
