(a) & (b): Central Institute of Plastics Engineering & Technology (CIPET) an autonomous institute under the Department of Chemicals & Petrochemicals is implementing a project titled 'Capacity Building of CIPET centres for development in Thrust areas' with soft loan assistance of US \$ 12.30 million from the Organisation of Petroleum Exporting Countries' (OPEC). The project objectives include augmentation of existing training and technical service facilities at various CIPET centres in the country.

The Government has opened three new CIPET centres at Aurangabad (Maharashtra), Panipat (Haryana) and Jaipur (Rajasthan) on the need and request of the respective State Government agreeing to bear the counterpart funding. Government has also sanctioned Rs.70.00 crores for CIPET New Schemes under the various Plan Schemes during XI Five Year Plan to upgrade and modernize in line with the Industry needs.
