(a)& (b) Under the National Rural Drinking Water Programme (NRDWP), which is a part of Bharat Nirman, the Government of India provides financial and technical assistance to States to supplement their efforts in providing adequate safe drinking water to the rural population. States can carry out activities related to Rural Drinking Water Supply through Panchyathi Raj Institutions (PRI's). The details of the expenditure of the activities carried out through PRI's are not maintained at the central level.
