(a) & (b): The Government of India has received proposal for diversification of agricultural crops for seeking financial assistance from Punjab state only. The Crop Diversification Programme is being implemented in Original Green Revolution States namely Punjab, Haryana and Uttar Pradesh to restore soil fertility and arrest depletion of ground water with an outlay of Rs.500 crores during year 2013-14.
