Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the State Council of Educational Research & Trainings (SCERTs) have full-time Sanskrit lecturers in their faculty;
- (b) if so, the number out of them imparting teacher training in Sanskrit; and
- (c) the State-wise number of Sanskrit teachers trained during 2008-09?

(a) to (c): State Councils of Educational Research & Training (SCERTs) are established by the respective State Governments. The appointment to the faculty positions is made in accordance with the rules and regulations of the concerned State Government. Under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Teacher Education, financial assistance is provided to SCERTs for infrastructural facilities, academic programmes etc on a shared pattern. Information relating to number of Sanskrit Lecturers in SCERTs and Sanskrit teachers trained by SCERTs is not maintained centrally.
