(b) whether the Indian High Commission and Embassies have taken any steps to protect Indian citizens abroad and ensure delivery of Justice to the victims; and

(a) : As reported by 111 Missions / posts abroad persons of Indian origin attacked abroad during the last three years and the current year are as follows:

Year- Number of incidents. 2010- 22 2011- 14 2012- 52 2013- 25 (upto 31.7.2013)

(b) and (c) : Indian Missions/Posts remain in touch with the local authorities and sensitize them of their concern about attacks on Indians and their safety. Indian Missions render necessary/ consular assistance to the victims/families. The Indian Missions/Posts facilitate the transportation of the mortal remains of the body to India if necessary. Assistance is also given from Indian Community Welfare Fund by the Indian Missions/Posts where necessary. Details are given in Annexure.
