- (f) whether any Indian Companies have been assigned the work of developing some stations as world-class; and
- (g) if so, the details thereof?

(a) to (g) For New Delhi Railway Station, various consultancies like architectural cum technical consultancy, legal consultancy, financial consultancy etc. have been awarded to professional consultants. Some reports have been submitted by the consultant. Matter is under discussion with local authorities like DDA, Jal Board, DUAC, traffic police etc. to sort out related issues and to get their clearances.

For Patna and Mumbai CST Railway station also, architectural cum technical consultancy contracts have been awarded.
