(a) & (b): The World Bank has provided funding for implementation of Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan programme in two spells namely Phase-I from 2004 to 2007 during which the Bank has reimbursed Rs. 2233.18 crore, and Phase-II from 2007 to 2010 during which the Bank has reimbursed Rs. 2736.16 crore. In respect of its commitments for Phase-II, the World Bank has reimbursed the entire amount.
