SETTING UP OF EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS UNDER PPP

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has decided to set up new polytechnics, degree colleges under the Public Private Partnership (PPP) during the 11th Five Year Plan period;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the number of each of such institutions which have started functioning during the current five year plan; and
- (d) the number of students so far benefited by such institutions in various States?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT(SMT. D. PURANDESWARI)

(a) to (d): The Government has decided to provide financial assistance for setting up of 300 polytechnics under Public Private Partnership (PPP) mode under the scheme of Sub-Mission on Polytechnics under Coordinated Action for Skill Development. Under this scheme, there is a provision to provide financial assistance of Rs.3.00 crores per polytechnic to the State Government/UTs for capital expenditure. As on date, no grants have been provided under this Scheme. Public Private Partnership cannot be ruled out under the Scheme of setting up of model Degree colleges in 374 Economically Backward Districts(EBDs).
