- (a) whether Airports Authority of India (AAI) has allotted land for development of Centrefor Perishable Cargo (CPC) at Ahmedabad Airport;
- (b) if so, the name of the agency;
- (c) whether AAI has issued NOC to the agency;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) if not, the reasons therefor?

Answer

(a) to (e): Airports Authority of India (AAI) had allotted land to M/s. Gujarat Agro Industries Corporation Ltd. (GAICL) for the setting up of a Centre for Perishable Cargo at Ahmedabad Airport. GAICL had entered into an agreement with M/s Cargo Service Centre (CSC) for operation and maintenance of the Perishable Cargo facility on revenue sharing model. GAICL has sought `No Objection Certificate` from AAI for outsourcing the facilityto CSC. However, AAI has not issued NoC to GAICL because as per the existing Perishable Cargo Policy, GAICL cannot outsource on revenue model to a third party.
