## MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (DR.SHASHI THAROOR)

(a): In addition to Sanskrit, Tamil, Kannada, Telugu and Malayalam are the regional languages which have been declared as Classical Languages by the Government of India.

(b): The details of the funds allocated and released for the development of Classical Languages in the country during the last three years and the current year, til date, are given below:-

(c) & (d): The Ministry of Human Resource Development issued an order on 29.9.2011 to establish the Centre of Excellence for Studies in Classical Kannada at the Central Institute of Indian Languages (CIIL), Mysore, a subordinate office of this Ministry and funds are allocated by this Ministry to CIIL for the Centre. However, the State Government of Karnataka has requested this Ministry to shift the Centre of Excellence for Studies in Classical Kannada from CIIL, Mysore to Bengaluru.
