Government of India supplements their efforts by providing, inter-alia, financial assistance to the NSFs for procurement of equipments and consumables, holding national/international sports events in India, participation of sportspersons/teams in international sports events abroad and training/coaching of national level sportspersons/teams through Indian and foreign coaches as per agreed Long Term Development Plans (LTDPs) with the NSFs under the 'Scheme of Assistance to National Sports Federations'. For football, such assistance is being provided to the All India Football Federation (AIFF).
