Urban Infrastructure Development Scheme for Small and Medium Towns (UIDSSMT) under Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission (JnNURM) in December, 2005 which caters for all the towns and cities of the country excluding 65 Mission cities covered under Urban Infrastructure & Governance (UIG), a sub-mission of JnNURM.
