(a) to (d): A number of ongoing schemes and programmes of the Ministry of Agriculture have an inbuilt component of capacity building and training of farmers in the field of agriculture and allied sectors. An illustrative list of such schemes is annexed. However, there is no specific scheme or programme only on skill development of farmers. While some schemes have earmarked allocation of funds for training, others are demand driven as per plans drawn up by the States and Implementing Agencies.
