**Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:**

- (a) the quantum of funds allocated to train teachers under the Sarva Shiksha Abhiyaan (SSA), State-wise;
- (b) the number of teachers trained under SSA during the last three years, State-wise;
- (c) whether the Union Government has found the cases of giving training to teachers only on the papers;
- (d) if so, the details thereof during the last three years;
- (e) the action taken by the Government in this regard and the outcome thereof; and
- (f) the reaction of the Government thereon?

(a) & (b): The Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA) provides funds to the States/UTs Government for the training of teachers at the elementary level in three categories, viz., a 20-day in-service training, 30-day induction training and the training of untrained teachers. The State-wise funds allocated under SSA for the training of teachers are at Annexure – I.

The State-wise progress achieved in respect of the training of teachers in each of these categories during the last three years is at Annexure – II.
