Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) is lagging behind State Boards in declaring their results;
- (b) if so, the reasons therefor; and
- (c) the steps taken or being taken by the CBSE to declare results of 10th and 12th standards well in time to help students to get admission in colleges?

Answer

(a) to (c): No Madam. The conduct of examinations and the declaration of results are part of a continuous process. Each board adheres to its own time table and it is erroneous to say that one board is lagging behind another. Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) follows a strict time frame for conducting of examinations and declaration of results. The examinations invariably start from 1st of March each year and results are declared by the end of May. In the last academic year i.e. 2012-13, the results for secondary and senior secondary examinations were declared on 27.05.2013 and 30.05.2013, respectively.
