(a) to (d): The Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA) is the main vehicle for the provision of Central funds for the implementation of the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education (RTE) Act, 2009. The details of funds released to States/UTs for last three years & current year is at Annexure. No objection has been raised by the Planning Commission to the release of these funds.
