(a) & (b) While state-wise details of number of medical teachers are not centrally maintained, there is a need for increasing number of medical teachers. For this purpose, the Central Government has taken steps to amend Medical Council of India Regulations by interalia relaxing teacher-student ratio from 1:1 to 1:2 and reducing the teaching experience to increase the availability of teaching faculty.
