- (a): The inspections are conducted under the provision of rule 156 of the Aircraft Rules 1937. The said rule empowers Director General of Civil Aviation to authorize any person including officer of surplus cell to enter and carry out inspection of operator of the aircraft and the organization by general or special order in writing in this behalf.
