(a) to (c) No, Sir. There is no such proposal in the Ministry. However, the Ministry of Environment & Forests administers The Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act, 1960 which aims to prevent the infliction of unnecessary pain or suffering on animals. Under the Act, Government has established the Animal Welfare Board of India (AWBI) for the promotion of animal welfare generally and for the purpose of protecting animals from being subjected to unnecessary pain or suffering, in particular.
