(a) to (c) Some reports of minor procedural irregularities at Passport Offices in Mallapuram and Kozhikode were brought to the notice of the Government. A fact finding team was deputed by the Ministry. Their report of the team did not find any irregularities as alleged. The matter was closed after the Central Vigilance Commission agreed to the report of the Ministry.
