(a) & (b): Yes, As per a survey based study "Corporate Workforce: chronic and Life Style Diseases" of the Associated Chamber of Commerce and Industry of India (ASSOCHAM), a large percentage of the country's workforce in different sectors are suffering from various chronic and life styls diseases including spondylisis, depression, obesity, sleeping disorder, high B.P., headache, fatigueness and diabetes.
