- (a) A Memorandum of Understanding between the Ministry of Road Transport and Highways of the Republic of India and the Department of Transport of Canada on Cooperation in Road Transportation was signed on the 11th June, 2012.
- (b) & (c) The MoU aims to establish a long-term and effective relationship of communication and cooperation, including the exchange of information between the Participants concerning highway development, management and administration; road safety; the application of advances technologies known as Intelligent Transportation System ("ITS") to road transportation; and other areas of mutual importance related to road and road transportation and raising awareness among private and public sector stakeholders on infrastructure investment opportunities in India and Canada, and facilitating collaboration and partnerships between Indian and Canadian stakeholders on infrastructure development. The MoU will benefit India for developing and promoting safe, efficient, cost effective, integrated and sustainable road transportation systems.
