Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the criteria adopted by the Railways for allotment and construction of rake points for fertilizers/commodities in the country;
- (b) the total number of rake points functioning and not functioning in the country, State-wise;
- (c) whether the rake points at Janjgir-Naila station under Bilaspur zone have become non-functional as the same were constructed despite not fulfilling the prescribed criteria;
- (d) if so, the reasons therefor along with the action taken/being taken by the Railways against those found responsible for such construction/allotment; and
- (e) whether the Railways propose to make the said rake point functional and if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

Answer

- (a) The rake points are planned/identified for fertilizers and all other commodities on the basis of operational requirement and commercial viability reflected through traffic projections, technical feasibility and resource availability.
