**Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the Government has urged all the States to set up integrated check posts so that checking by all the concerned departments could be done simultaneously at a common point;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government has fixed any timeframe for setting up of these integrated check posts; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

**Answer**

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI SARVEY SATHYANARAYANA)

- (a) & (b) Yes, Madam. With a view to promote seamless movement of goods vehicles across the country, the Ministry of Road Transport and Highways has requested all States / Union Territories except Union Territories of Andaman and Nicobar Islands and Lakshadweep to set up Inter-State Check Posts (ISCPs) in their States / Union Territories and furnish details viz. number of computerised ISCPs, ISCPs involved in export of containers and policy initiatives undertaken by the States/UTs to promote seamless quick clearance at ISCPs.
