(b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise and location-wise; and

(c) the time by which these universities/colleges are likely to be established?

(a) to (c): No, Madam. At present the Government proposes to set-up only one central university exclusively for women at Raebareli, Uttar Pradesh. It is proposed to set up this University during the current Plan period.
