NETWORK SERVER PROBLEMS IN CGHS DISPENSARIES

Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

(a) whether the network/server/computers provided at the Central Government Health Scheme (CGHS) dispensaries are obsolete and break down frequently resulting in unnecessary delay and long queues of patients;

(b) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor; and

(c) the time by which the heavy duty servers and computers with updated technology are likely to be provided at CGHS dispensaries?

(a) & (b): There are occasional instances of technical break down of the network/server in CGHS Wellness Centres. However, manual operations are initiated to continue to provide medical facilities to patients in case of breakdown.

(c): Old computers and other accessories are replaced as and when there is need for replacement of hardware and condemnation of equipment.
