Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether announcement for operation of new trains from Jodhpur to Guwahati 15623/15624 and from Bandra terminal to Hisar 22915/22916 were made in the Rail Budget 2013-14;
- (b) if so, the reasons for non operation of the said trains and the time by which these trains are likely to be made operational;
- (c) whether the Railways propose to convert bi-weekly train No. 22481/22482 Jodhpur-Ratangar- Delhi Sarai Rohilla Super fast train into daily train and extend it upto Haridwar; and
- (d) if so, the time by which it is likely to be done and if not, the reasons therefor?

Answer

MINISTER OF THE STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI ADHIR RANJAN CHOWDHURY)

- (a) & (b) Yes, Madam. 22915/22916 Bandra Terminus-Hisar Express (Weekly) has been introduced w.e.f. 24.01.2014. However, 15623/15624 Jodhpur-Kamakhya (Guwahati) Express (Weekly) is yet to be introduced. Generally, train services announced in the Railway Budget are to be introduced during the course of same financial year.
- (c) & (d) Increase in frequency and extension of existing train services is an on-going process subject to traffic justification, operational feasibility, availability of resources etc. However, presently, there is no proposal to increase the frequency and to extend 22481/22482 Jodhpur-Delhi Sarai Rohilla Express upto Haridwar due to operational and resource constraints.
