- (c) the time by which the work on the said projects is likely to be started?

- (a) & (b) No joint study for semi high speed trains on Delhi-Mumbai Corridor has been undertaken. However, Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA) had funded a study for semi high speed trains between Mumbai-Delhi and Mumbai-Ahmedabad in 2012-13.
- (c) At present, no project for operation of semi high speed trains has been sanctioned for implementation.
