The Department called a meeting of the representatives of association of traders and manufacturers and directed them to sort out the issue. However, a communication has been received from one of the Industry Associations requesting the Government to intervene to resolve the issue amicably. The issue is being examined in line with the provisions under National Pharmaceutical Pricing Policy 2012 and Drugs Prices Control Order 2013.
