- (c) the steps taken/proposed to be taken by the Government to fix reasonable prices for generic drugs?

All medicines specified in National List of essential Medicines 2011 (NLEM-2011) have been include in Schedule-I of the DPCO, 2013 and brought under price control. Para 4 of the DPCO, 2013 provides for fixing ceiling prices scheduled drugs, including those of generic drugs.
