- (a) whether any proposal to increase the frequency of Train No. 2236/2235 New Delhi- Dibrugarh Rajdhani Express from once in a week to five/seven days a week is pending before the Railways;
- (b) if so, the time by which it is likely to be implemented; and
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor?

- (a) Large number of proposals for increase in frequency of existing trains including 12235/12236 New Delhi-Dibrugarh Rajdhani Express are received at various levels of railway administration and action as found feasible & justified is taken subject to traffic justification, operational feasibility, availability of resources, etc. However, a compendium of such proposals is not maintained by Indian Railways.
- (b) & (c) At present, there is no proposal to increase the frequency of 12235/12236 New Delhi -Dibrugarh Rajdhani Express due to operational & resource constraints.
