(a)to(d) Survey for new line between Ghanauli and Dehradun (via Jagadhari, Surajpur, Baddi, Nalagarh, Kala Amb and Paonta Sahib) has been completed and as per the survey report, the cost of construction of this 216 Km long new line has been assessed as Rs. 3745.62 crore with a rate of return of (-) 0.40%. The project proposal could not be advanced as necessary approval from Planning Commission was not received.
