- (a): Yes, Madam. The Government has announced institutional partnership projects with the United States of America, the United Kingdom, Australia, New Zealand, Israel, Germany and Norway during the last three years.
- (b): The institutional partnership projects with these countries are envisaged with joint funding commitments from both sides. The financial commitment of the Government for the above countries is as follows:
- 1. United States of America US Dollar 5 million over a period of five years 2. United Kingdom GBP 2.5 million per annum 3. Australia AUD 300,000 for one year 4. New Zealand NZD 1 million per annum 5. Israel Upto USD 2.5 million per annum 6. Germany Euro 3.5 million for 4 years 7. Norway 8.5 million NOK for 5 years The partnerships are aimed at forging knowledge collaborations between Indian institutions and their counterparts in the respective countries for taking up joint research projects in thematic priority areas, professional and leadership development of faculty, mobility of researchers and students, skill development, etc.
