- (a) whether the Government hasassessed the performance of various States/Union Territories (UTs) under MahatmaGandhi National Rural EmploymentGuarantee Scheme (MGNREGS):
- (b) if so, the details thereof indicatingthe names of the States/UTsimplementing the Scheme effectively andthe States/UTs lagging behind in this regard;
- (c) whether the Government proposesto reward the States/UTs for betterimplementation of MGNREGS;
- (d) if so, the details thereof, State/UT-wise;
- (e) the details of the provisions and time-frame laid down for transfer of nodalofficers responsible for implementation of the Scheme;
- (f) whether it is a fact that benefits underMGNREGS are accruing the to influentialpersons including Sarpanch instead of poor/BPL people; and (g) if so, the reaction of the Governmentthereto?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI PRADEEP JAIN 'ADITYA')

- (a) & (b): Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act (MGNREGA) is a demand-driven and right based wage employment programme. As per information provided by the States/UTs in the programme MIS, the average persondays generated at the national level was 46 days per rural householdin the financial year (FY) 2012-13. During the same period eighteen States have reported average persondays per household lower than the national average. The State/UTs-wise average persondays per household generated under MGNREGA are indicated in Annexure.
- (c) & (d): The Ministry has awarded five States viz. Bihar, Chhattisgarhi Sikkim, Tamil Nadu and Andhra Pradesh for effective implementation of activities under MGNREGA during the financial year 2012-13.
- (e): There is no provision and time frame laid down by the Ministry for transfer of nodal officers responsible for implementation under Scheme as the responsibility of implementation of provision under MGNREGA is vested with States/UTs.
- (f) & (g): MGNREGAis a demand drivenand self targeting wage employment programme. States/UTs, being the implanting agencies, are responsible for effective implementation of the Scheme under MGNREGA.
